

Your flight got cancelled due to Covid-19 and still no return of your flight ticket?



Use your right to compensation!

Travelling by plane can be stressful, but having boarding declined, or your flight cancelled on the spot can be very frustrating, not to mention all the myriad of flights canceled due to the Covid pandemic.

So far, a significant number of passengers have not received the refund for their flight ticket. Whatever the case, you need to know, that sitting and waiting to get your money back or endure the inconvenience of a flight delay is not your only choice. Use your right to compensation!

Cases of flight cancellations and delays of over 3 hours are eligible for a compensation of 250- 600 EUR/person (depending on the flight distance). If the airline declines your claim, the applicable EU Regulation provides the opportunity (and the legal conditions) to enforce your claim by a European Payment Order – EPO (ordered by the notary in Hungary).

Once the EPO form sheet is filed with the competent notary public, your case is all set for the following legal actions, in which procedure your lawyer can represent you. Your right to compensation is the best way to make sure, that your unpleasant experience with the airline gets sorted out - in some degree. Next time you find yourself in a situation like this, make sure you use the chances provided to you and take the necessary steps to reduce the damages caused by the airline.
